1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing one of the Enjoy Birds More family of products. We hope you will enjoy many years of listening to and watching animals and birds with your Wildlife Listener - Viewer.

2. Setting Up Your Equipment

The Wildlife Listener - Viewer consists of 2 main components:

1. Long distance microphone and associated electronics
2. Headphones



It is easy to put the product together by following these step by step instructions.

3. **Unpack Your Wildlife Listener - Viewer**

Carefully remove all the components from the box and packaging.

As well as this User Guide, you should have the following parts in your kit:

Parabolic Dish to focus the sounds



Main Unit containing microphone, amplifier, digital sound clip recorder and sighting telescope



Headphones for listening to the secret sounds of nature



Duster

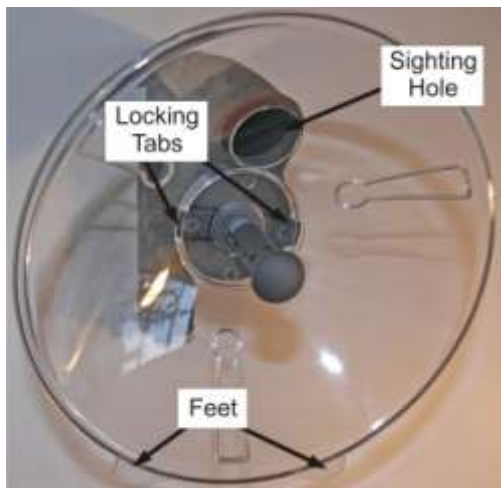


4. Setting Up Your Equipment for Operation

4.1 Fit the Parabolic Dish to the Front of the Main Unit.

The dish needs to be facing away from the Main Unit with its feet at the bottom, and the oval sighting hole lining up with the sighting telescope

Attach it securely to the front of the Main Unit by gently squeezing the 2 locking tabs on the Main Unit, while locating the tabs through the slots for them in the dish.



4.2 Fit a Battery

This product requires one PP3 battery (which is not supplied).

To insert the battery, loosen the screw on the battery compartment (located at the end of the Main Unit's handle), open the small door, snap the battery onto the connections and close it up.

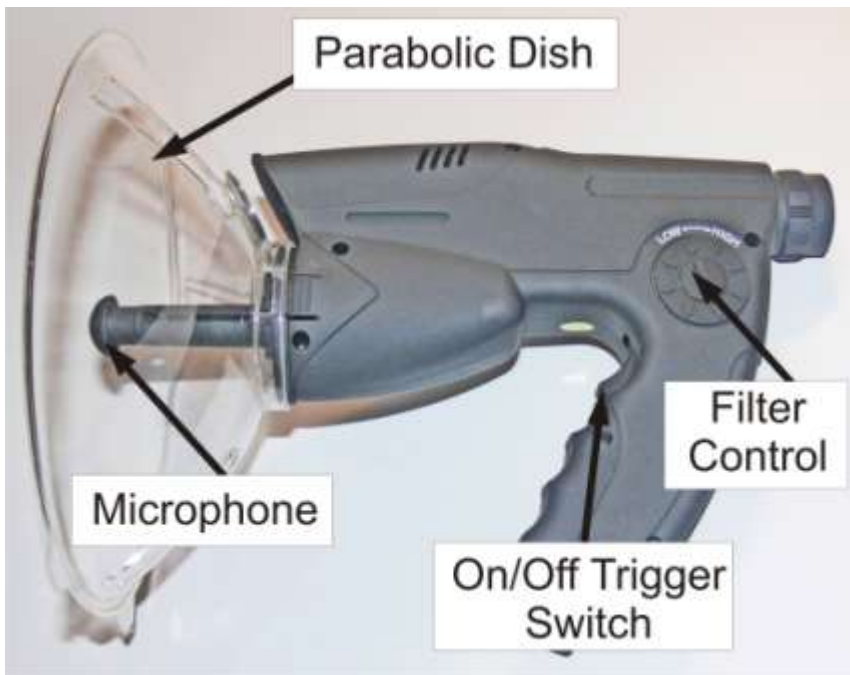


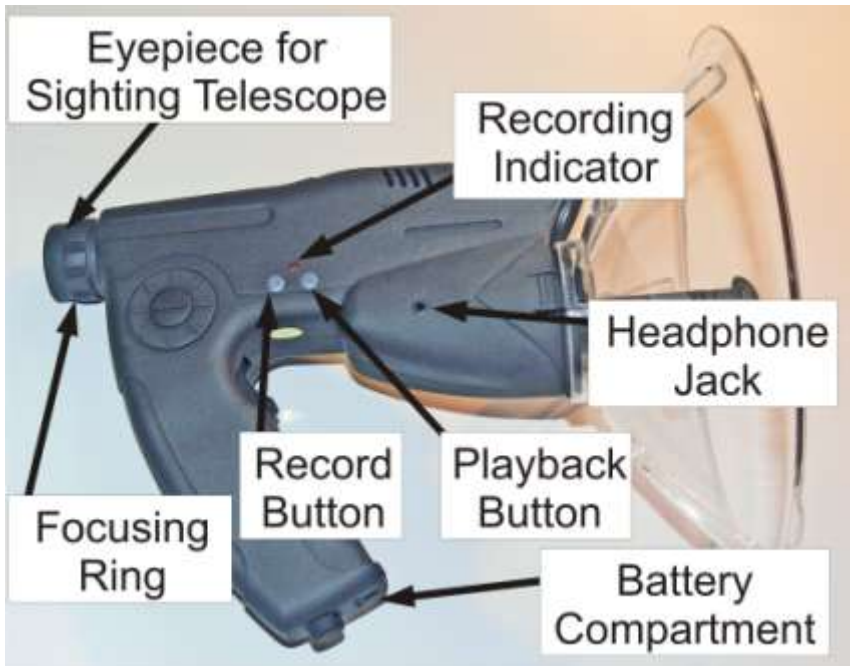
5. Use of the Wildlife Listener - Viewer

You are now ready to start using your product.

5.1 Controls and Features

These are the controls and features of the Main Unit:





5.2 Headphones

Plug in the headphones to the Headphone Jack, place them on your head and adjust for comfortable listening.



5.3 Telescope

The Sighting Telescope allows you to accurately aim the device, and see what you are listening to. It has an 8 times magnification prism based optical system.



Look through this and adjust the focusing ring to give a clear image.

NEVER LOOK AT THE SUN THROUGH THE TELESCOPE, AS PERMANENT EYE DAMAGE COULD RESULT.

5.4 Listening

Squeeze the On/Off Trigger Switch and you will hear the sounds coming from your chosen direction.

5.5 Filter Control

The unit incorporates a variable frequency filter to enable you to partly reduce the impact of unwanted background sounds. Turn the control to adjust the frequency to be reduced.

5.6 Sound Recording

The inbuilt digital recorder can record a sound clip of up to approximately 12 seconds. To record a clip, simply press the Record Button and keep pressing it until you have finished recording. The Recording Indicator lights up as red while you are recording. It doesn't matter whether the On/Off Trigger Switch is on or off.

Every time you press the Record Button, the previous recording will be erased.

5.7 Sound Playback

To hear what you have recorded, press and hold down the Playback Button.

5.8 Saving or Amplifying Your Audio Clips

To save your clips for future use, or just play them back louder, unplug the Headphones, and plug in an audio lead with a standard 3.5mm stereo lead, connected to a sound recorder or computer or amplifier. Play back the sounds as if through the headphones, and record if you wish.
